Dear Parent and Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well. I have been here for over half a term now, and I have gained a thorough understanding of the school's current strengths and areas for improvement, including taking on board the survey responses from parents. In the first two weeks, I conducted my own review, collaborating with two other Hillingdon headteachers and a school improvement advisor. Since then, as you are aware, we have had a visit from Ofsted.

I cannot share the judgement at this time (due to the report having to be completed and then quality assured by the central Ofsted team) but I can say that the inspection was fair, transparent, and collaborative. It has also validated my own assessment and evaluation of the school. While I have already had the pleasure of meeting many of you, I would like to hold some parent meetings where I can formally introduce myself and share the school's priorities going forward. Once the Ofsted report is published (may take up to 4 weeks or so), I will be sure to share it with all of you.

The date and times for the upcoming parent meetings are as follows, **Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2024 at either 9:15am or 5:00pm**

I have tried to do one in the morning as well as early evening in order to suit as many parents as possible. Charlotte Moore, Chair of Governors will also be present at these meetings. This meeting is for parents so I kindly request that children are not present.

I can then address your questions during the session. All information shared will be available to you via email after the events and I do plan to hold more parent engagement meetings if you are unable to attend on the 20<sup>th</sup> June.
